Day 1

Meet & Assist upon arrival to Queen Alia International Airport. Transfer to **Amman** for **Over Night**.

Day 2

After Breakfast; Start **Amman City** Tour, Driving through the Old and the New City visiting Citadel; Temple of Hercules; Omayyad Palace, Byzantine Church and Jordan Archaeological Museum, then drive to visit the **Desert Castles**; back to **Amman** for **Over Night**.



Day 3

After Breakfast; Visit to **Jerash** one of the best preserves Roman Tone in the world. Today you can walk through "Street of Columns". The Two Huge Temples of Zeus and Airtimes and a lot of other different sites, then continue to **Um Qais/Gadara** is one of the most unique Greco-Roman Decapolis sites with panoramic view over Golan Heights; Syrian mountains and Sea of Galilee today's Lake Tiberius; drive back to **Amman** for **Over Night**.

Day 4

After Breakfast; Drive to **Madaba** to visit St. George's Greek Orthodox Church in Madaba, Mosaic map build on the Sixth Century AD. It is the oldest preserved and most detailed ancient map of the Holy Land; from Lebanon to Egypt, Then drive **Mt. Nebo** (Siyagha) is the memorial of Prophet Moses. Later on continue to **Petra** for **Over Night**.



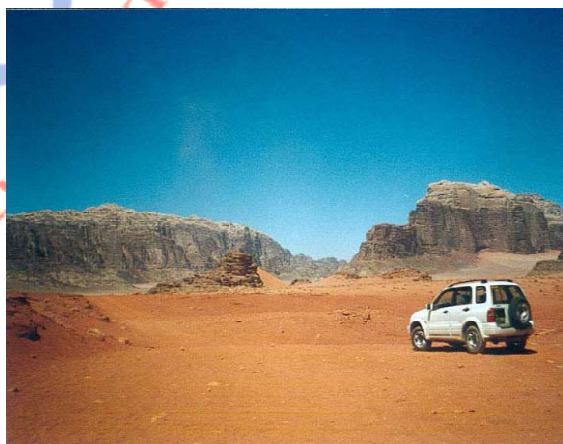


Day 5

After Breakfast; Your ultimate destination is the astonishing rose-red city of **Petra**; This was built by Nabateans (An early Arab people). Petra was renowned for its massive architecture; pools; Dams and water channels. Petra is the legacy of the Nabateans who settle in the South of Jordan more than 2 thousand years ago. The TREASURY; Royal Tombs; The Court; Roman Theatre; Roman Street; Petra Museum with a possibility to visit one of the two highest points of Petra; The Monastery, almost 850 high or the high Place of Sacrifice, almost 600 steps high, back to **Petra** for **Over Night**.

Day 6

After breakfast; Pick up by 4X4 jeeps, driven by professional Bedouin drivers and journey to the sandstone area of **Wadi Rum**. We go off-road into its unique landscape and get off the beaten track to explore rarely traveled ancient merchant routes. Lunch is enjoyed outdoors. We continue off-road through the Rum and by evening reach a Bedouin hospitality camp, here we enjoy our **evening meal** and settle for the night in a **guest tent**. In **Wadi Rum** we have the opportunity to witness the awe-inspiring Arabian night-skies and the enchanting views of Wadi Rum.



Day 7:

After Breakfast; Optional Tours of Ballooning; Biking; Hiking or Climbing in **Wadi Rum**; return to Amman for free evening for shopping and **Over Night**.

After Breakfast; Transfer to Queen Alia International Airport for departure.
