## Day 3

After Breakfast; Visit to Jerash one of the best preserves Roman Tone in the world. Today you can walk through "Street of Columns". The Two Huge Temples of Zeus and Airtimes and a lot of other different sites, then continue to Um Qais/Gadara is one of the most unique Greco-Roman Decapolis sites with panoramic view over Golan Heights; Syrian mountains and Sea of Galilee today's Lake Tiberius; drive back to Amman for Over Night.



## Day 4

After Breakfast; Drive to Madaba to visit St. George's Greek Orthodox Church in Madaba, Mosaic map build on the Sixth Century AD. It is the oldest preserved and most detailed ancient map of the Holy Land; from Lebanon to Egypt, Then drive Mt. Nebo (Siyagha) is the memorial of Prophet Moses. Later on continue to Petra for Over Night.

### Day 5

After Breakfast; Your ultimate destination is the astonishing rose-red city of Petra; This was built by Nabateans (An early Arab people). Petra was renowned for its massive architecture; pools; Dams and water channels. Petra is the legacy of the Nabateans who settle in the South of Jordan more than 2 thousand years ago. The TREASURY; Royal Tombs; The Court; Roman Theatre; Roman Street; Petra Museum with a possibility to visit one of the two highest points of Petra; The Monastery, almost 850 high or the high Place of Sacrifice, almost 600 steps high, back to Petra for Over Night.

### Day 6

After breakfast; Pick up by 4X4 jeeps, driven by professional Bedouin drivers and journey to the sandstone area of Wadi Rum. We go off-road into its unique landscape and get off the beaten track to explore rarely traveled ancient merchant routes. Lunch is enjoyed outdoors. We continue off-road through the Rum and by evening reach a Bedouin hospitality camp, here we enjoy our evening meal and settle for the night in a guest tent In Wadi Rum we have the opportunity to witness the awe-inspiring Arabian night-skies and the enchanting views of Wadi Rum.



### Day 7:

After Breakfast; Optional Tours of Ballooning; Biking; Hiking or Climbing in **Wadi Rum**; return to Amman for free evening for shopping and **Over Night**.

After Breakfast; Transfer to Queen Alia International Airport for departure.
